

MCC 2017 User Guide

Contest

1. Access the contest site at mcc.ioimalaysia.org.
2. Sign in using the login credentials that you should have received by email.
3. Click **Problems** to view the problems.
4. For each problem, the statement will be shown in the left pane while tasks will be shown in the right pane.
5. To submit your answer for a task, type/paste it into the Answer box.
6. The maximum number of submissions allowed for each task will be displayed near the bottom right corner of the screen, above the submit button. Use your submissions wisely!

Past submissions

1. You can click **Submissions** to view the submissions you've made.
2. You can click on the ID of a submission to see the full details of the submission made.

Scoring

1. For each problem, there will be one or more test-cases. If your submission for a test-case is correct, you will receive full score for that test-case. Otherwise, you will receive 0 for that test-case.
2. You can view your score for each problem by going to the **Problems** tab.

Code

1. You may use any programming language (or none at all) to aid in solving the problems.
2. If you do not have a local programming environment on your machine, we recommend that you use repl.it to write and execute code. E.g. you can write and execute python code at repl.it/languages/python.
3. Please save any code that you've used to solve the problems. We will ask you to upload your code during the exit interview.

Exit Interview

1. After the contest, there will be a link to the exit interview on the contest site.
2. Please submit any code you've used.

3. Please declare all websites you've consulted. (This is not a violation of the honour code).
4. **You will be awarded 10 extra points for completing the exit interview.**

Honour Code

All participants in MCC agree to that he or she will:

- Not discuss the problems with anyone else during the competition time;
- Neither share solutions nor post solutions online during the competition time;
- Notify the organisers (mcc [at] ioimalaysia [dot] org) immediately if he or she becomes aware of other participants cheating.

During the competition, usage of search engines like Google and access to all online references like Python Tutorial are permitted. When in doubt about whether some resource is permitted, please email the organizers for clarification.
